This shows the woodwork. The dash, door caps, shift knob, and custom steering wheel are all matching AAAA grade burl black walnut.



The paint is Moss Green metallic urethane. The body trim is satin black as was the original. All of the interior will be a light beige as can be seen on the dash and windscreen frame.
